RE: Updated Letter from HOWAE re Water Shutdown

Dear Residents:

We are pleased to share some good news regarding the District's non-potable irrigation water supply.

The Hunters Overlook Water Activity Enterprise ("HOWAE") has continued working to secure additional water for the community and has successfully obtained additional rental water and arranged for its delivery to the system.

As a result, the District will be able to extend the non-potable irrigation season through September 30, 2026, rather than shutting the system down on September 24 as previously announced.

This is good news for the community, but continued conservation remains important. Residents must continue to follow the current watering schedule and the 20-minute-per-zone limitation and should continue to avoid leaks, runoff, and unnecessary water use.

The additional water will help extend the irrigation season, but the available supply remains limited. Continued cooperation will help ensure the system can remain operational through September 30.

The non-potable irrigation system is now scheduled to shut down on October 1, 2026.
